HIGH HAND PROMOTION

The High Hand promotion will take place in the Golden Nugget Poker Room each day between 12pm - 12am

- 1. Promotion times will be between 12pm 12am every day. The first hourly winner will be at 1pm and will be for the high hand between 12pm and 1pm.
- 2. There will also be a potential winner at 2pm, 3pm, 4pm, 5pm, 6pm, 7pm, 8pm, 9pm, 10pm, 11pm and 12am.
- 3. The winner of the high hand will spin the Money Wheel for an opportunity to win up \$1000. The wheel must make 3 full rotations to be deemed valid. In the event the Money Wheel is not utilized, the winner of the high hand will draw their winning prize amount from a raffle drum. Prize money dollar amounts on the Money Wheel and in the raffle drum are equivalent amounts.
- 4. Hands must be verified by a supervisor.
- 5. Players must use both of their cards to qualify for a high hand, there is no minimum amount needed in the pot, and the hand does not have to go to showdown. When using both of their cards both cards must play. If the High Hand is Quads the kicker can be used as long as it is higher than the other 2 cards on board. Suits will determine which kicker is higher.
- 6. Aces full of Kings will be the minimum starting hand needed to collect high hand prize.
- 7. A High Hand Log will be kept for each gaming day. The supervisor who verified the hand will record the player's name, account number, high hand and initial in the box marked recorded by. All qualifying hands will be logged.
- 8. Any prize money not awarded will not carry over to the following hour or day.
- 9. If the highest hand ends in a tie, both players will spin the wheel or draw from the raffle drum. The highest prize money amount will be divided equally amongst the two players.
- 10. Texas Hold'em Bad Beat eligible games only can qualify
- 11. There must be 4 active players on the game to qualify for a High Hand.
- 12. Hands that start before the hour will count. A hand has officially started with the first riffle on a hand shuffled game and when the dealer cuts the deck on a machine shuffled game.
- 13. The rank of suits from Low to High for purposes of straight flushes and higher shall be: Clubs, Diamonds, Hearts then Spades.
- 14. Supervisor will verify all hands are completed for the hour before declaring a winner. The winner(s) names will be highlighted on the High Hand log and the Supervisor will note the amount won next to the name.
- 15. The official clock will be at the Poker Podium.
- 16. Players must be in the Poker Room in order to win the prize when it is announced. In the event that a winner is not present, then the player(s) with the next highest qualifying hand on the log will be called. If no winners are available to claim the prize, the money will be paid to the highest hand winner.
- 17. Golden Nugget Poker management reserves the right to cancel, change, and modify the tournament, promotion or drawing.

In the event a hand qualifies for more than one promotional prize, the guest must make their choice of promotion. They will not be paid for more than one promotion. If the guest opts for a promotional payout other that the High Hand prize, his or her hand must be beat in order for the High Hand of the hour to be paid. Any perceived indication of collusion will disqualify payment of any High Hand award.
